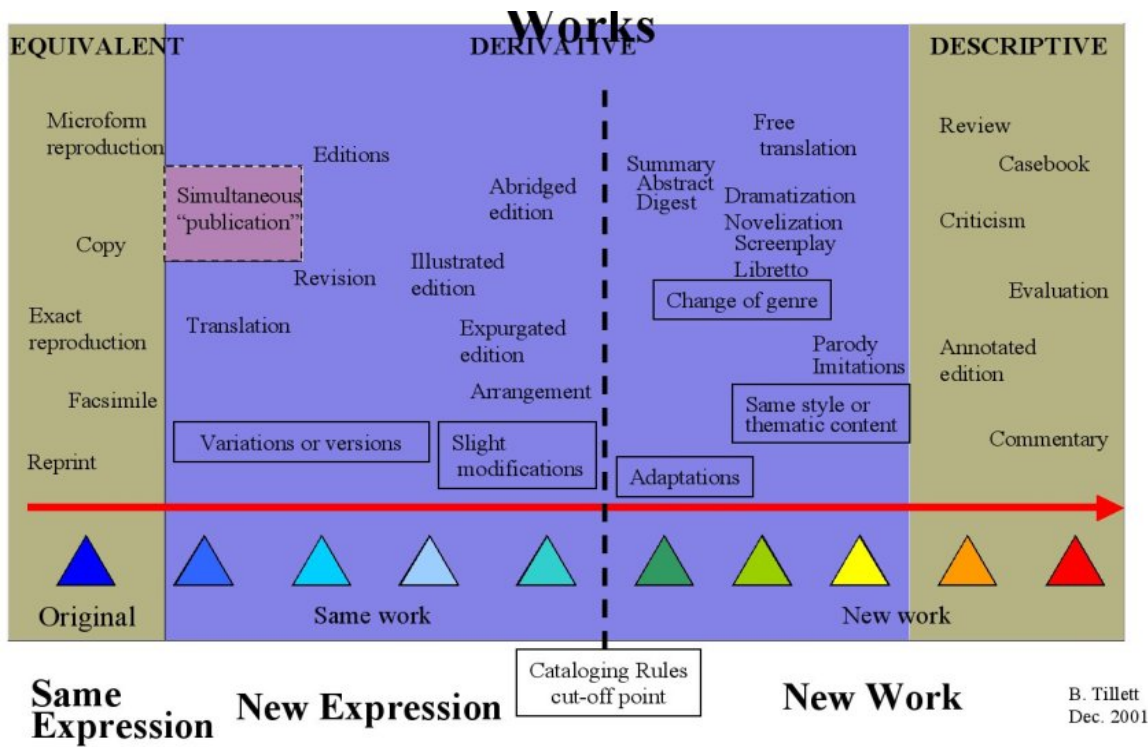


Figure 1: Barbara Tillet’s Family of Works diagram; taken from Barbara B. Tillet, "Bibliographic Relationships," in *Relationships in the Organization of Knowledge*, edited by Carol A. Bean and Rebecca Green, 19-35. Dordrecht: Kluwer Academic Publishers, 2001.

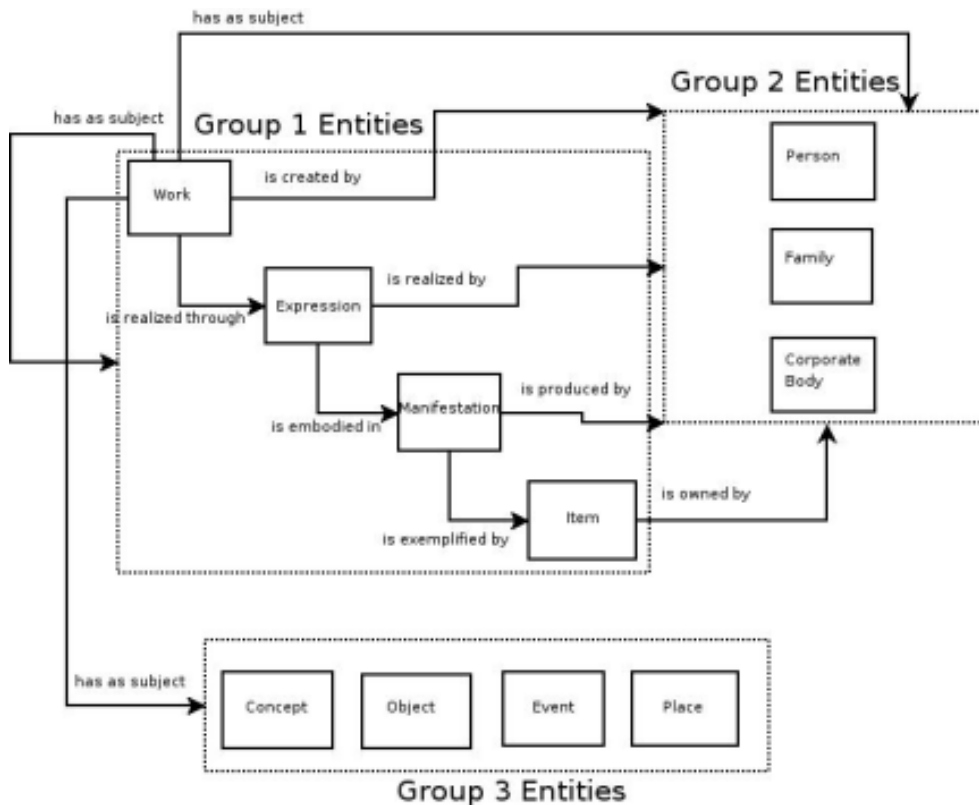


Figure 2: Groups 1, 2, and 3 Entities and their relationships; based on diagrams from *FRBR Final Report*
